Student Minister Job Description

Overview

The Student Minister reports to the Senior Pastor and Personnel Committee and works with the members of the church body to fulfill the vision and mission of Sharon Baptist Church by overseeing and coordinating all ministries and programs for children and youth from kindergarten through high school.

Position Requirements

- Maturing Christian believer
- Undergraduate degree
- Seminary degree, or the desire to pursue seminary training, is highly regarded
- Calling demonstrated through ministry experience

Children's Ministry (K-5)

- Recruit and oversee Children's Ministry leaders in such positions as: Children's Ministry Director, AWANA Commander, VBS Director, etc.
- Administer the Upward Basketball and Cheerleading program, working with the Upward Committee and volunteers.
- Ensure Children Ministry leaders are properly equipped and trained to successfully reach their objectives and goals.
- Be the staff point person for Children's Ministry related annual events such as: VBS, Fall Festival, etc.

- Conduct Pastoral care duties for K-5 students as guided by the Senior Pastor.

Student Ministry (6-12)

- Serve as the Ministry Director for the Student Ministry, being the primary architect for the Student Ministry.
- Recruit, organize, train, and oversee the appropriate volunteers to accomplish student ministry work.
- Provide vision and direction for the intentional discipleship of SBC Students.
- Establish an ongoing presence on the campus of schools (as allowed) or at extracurricular events.
- Coordinate a calendar of ministry activity including events that include items such as: camp, mission trips, conferences, etc.
- Perform pastoral care duties for 6-12 students as guided by the Senior Pastor.

Staff Expectations

- Cooperate with staff to assist in achieving church vision and missions.
- Work with other staff to develop annual budget for related ministries recommendation to be provided to the budget committee.
- Attend and participate in staff meetings.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor.
- Work with appropriate church committees as needed/required.
